Public consultation on proposals to build a secure psychiatric hospital in Barlborough.

We have produced this Special Edition Newsletter to draw your attention to the proposals by a private company Cygnet Healthcare to build a secure psychiatric hospital in Barlborough. The proposed site is on land between Chesterfield Road and Midland Way. As your Parish Council we consider it is important that you are made aware of these proposals, so you can make your views known should you wish to do so.

In response to requests from local residents, Barlborough Parish Council will be holding a public meeting in **Barlborough Village Hall at 7.00pm on Friday 9th March, 2007**. All your local Councillors will be invited and representatives from Cygnet Healthcare will be there.

Additionally, from Thursday 1st March, the Plans will be on display in the village hall together with comments slips. A tear-off slip is also attached to this newsletter. If you would like to ask a question at the public meeting on the 9th, it would be helpful if you could complete a slip and return it to the Parish Office by Thursday 8th March.
